## Participants Will Receive...

Customized curriculum/materials to establish a program	The OPMP trainer will assist participants in creating a customizable peer mediation training program for students. Materials include adult training for the peer coordinator, student training, videos, handouts, role-plays, scenarios, and lessons. Some lessons include self-awareness, overview of conflict, responses to conflict, bullying awareness, neuroscience of conflict, communication skills, mediation process, ethical standards, bias awareness,
Coaching	cultural considerations, role plays, problem solving models, culture, and conflict scenarios.  Staff members will receive coaching services for creating a school mediation program. In addition, staff will have the opportunity to troubleshoot potential problems and setbacks.
Consultation time frame	One year – Staff members have the option to extend the consultation timeframe.
Online Peer Mediation Training/Student Simulations	OPMP staff will assist coordinators in creating role plays and simulations for students.
